Applications along with Bio-data and copies of testimonials are invited from intending candidates, for one post of Faculty Member (on contractual basis) in consolidated pay of Rs.35,000/- p.m. as per conditions of service given below, for imparting training to Judicial Officers and other participants undergoing training at Odisha Judicial Academy, Cuttack. The candidate should be an officer of the retired District Judge cadre having experience in teaching/imparting training. The candidate desirous to apply for the post must be willing to attend the Academy on Sundays/holidays in which training programme, if any, is scheduled.

Eligibility Conditions:

- (i) Officers who have retired from Government service on attaining the age of superannuation and below the age of sixty five years having good service records and are physically fit shall be eligible to be considered for re-employment against the above posts.
- (ii) Officers against whom departmental proceedings or criminal cases are contemplated / pending or who have been penalized for misconduct during the period of preceding five years will not be eligible for consideration.

Selection Process:

- (i) Selection of persons will be made by a Selection Committee as may be constituted by the Hon'ble Chairman of the Odisha Judicial Academy & Training Committee.

Tenure, Terms & Conditions:

- (i) The re-employment shall be made initially for a period of one year and can be extended for subsequent period of two years with spells of one year each subject to satisfactory performance up to a total period of four

years not beyond the age of sixty-five years of age in any case or till the posts are filled up by regular process whichever is earlier.

- (ii) Re-employed officers will be entitled to consolidated pay of Rs.35,000/- p.m.
- (iii) Re-employed officers shall be governed by the provisions of Odisha Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1957 and shall be liable to be proceeded against for their misconduct, omissions and commissions as per the provisions under the Odisha Pension Rules, 1992.
- (iv) The re-employment can be terminated at any time by the respective appointing authority due to unsatisfactory performance of any of the re-employed officer by giving one month notice. On the contrary, if any re-employed officer desires to resign he shall do so by giving one month's written notice to the competent authority.

Last Date of receipt of application:

The application for the above referred post must be received only through speed post, by the undersigned on or before 09.02.2017. Any application received after the prescribed last date shall be summarily rejected.
